John Nixon has been President now for a very long time and will



Why We Ride - The Film!

I just received word that a new movie is being released November 1, 2013 called Why We Ride.

If you click on the link here... you can watch a brief trailer of this film. http://whyweridefilm.com/screeenings-video.html or visit the films website at www.whyweridefilm.com Among people I recognized in the trailer are David "Huggy Bear" Hansen, (orange shop shirt), owner for 40+ years of The Shop in Ventura California. A couple of years back two men approached David and wanted to interview him on The Life of Ed Kretz. David did so and also offered other people they could interview on Kretz's life. Within a short period of time after interviewing other motorcycle enthusiasts about Kretz, the movie duo returned to David's Shop and told him although they still wanted to do the documentary on Ed Kretz, they were so blown away by "the passion" that these interviewees had for their own motorcycles and the sport of motorcycling that they decided to do the film also on 'Why We Ride?"

In essence this film will be a "modern day version of the 1971 movie On Any Sunday", which was produced by Bruce Brown, financed partially by actor / rider Steve McQueen and showcased virtually all types of riding in our sport. There were no actors in On Any Sunday and now it is recognized as the first true "Reality Movie" where only real riders such as McQueen, Dave Smith (Lumberton TX), Malcolm Smith, Mert Lawwill, and the then young and crazy Dave Aldana were featured. The film was nominated for an Academy Award in 1972, although it did not win it. On Any Sunday has become a true biker cult classic alongside Easy Riders and The Wild Ones.

Also of note in this trailer of Why We Ride is Gloria Trenantin. She is wearing the light blue Motor Maids t-shirt, as she normally does. Gloria was born in 1925 in a room behind her father's motorcycle shop in New Jersey. At a very young age her older brother basically forced her to ride a motorcycle when she did not want to and history was born. Gloria has been a Motor Maid for over 55 years the last I knew. She still rides and was at the red carpet Hollywood Premier for this movie last week with her daughter and granddaughter. You may recognize some people I do not in this trailer. You may recognize or even know people in the actual movie that I do not. But David "Huggy Bear" Hansen has assured me it is truly an awesome movie to see. Take your friends, your kids and your grandkids!

I am simply very excited and proud to share this opportunity with you all in this newsletter and hope you will watch for its announcement in a movie theatre near you **November 1**st of very close thereafter. See... we can all still write history in our sport for those who follow us!




